Kay Hannah

Kay Hannah of *Scrap and Stash Buster Inchoate* is an avid quilt maker and designer who hails from Acton, Ontario and is a member of the Erin Village Quilters.



Although Kay has been sewing since she was five, she didn't start making quilts until 1990. Her vice is quilting fabrics and Kay spends most of her days taming the monster "Stash" as well as capturing her creative ideas before they fleet away.



Since retiring from teaching Home Economics/Family Studies in 1997 she has been quilting, teaching workshops and hosting retreats. Once a teacher, always a teacher. Multi-fabric quilts are Kay's forte and she seldom works from a commercial pattern. Kay loves to play 'what if' and think outside the box designing traditional looking quilts with a contemporary feel.

Her trunk show will feature quilts from different collections of work: Gremlins in my Studio, Layer Four and Cut, Working the Greens, I've Got the Quilting Blues and Good the Last Crumb. The presentation focuses on ideas for using your stash under the title KISS the 2022 ECONOMY.



To choose the proper batting size, add 4" to the size of your quilt top and pick that or the next higher batting size.

Crib Quilt	45" x 60"
Twin Quilt	72" x 90"
Double Quilt	81" x 96"
Queen Quilt	90" x 108"
King Quilt	120" x 120"

Yardage Chart

The numbers are based on 44" wide fabric. This should help you estimate the amount of fabric you will need for whatever number or size blocks you choose to make. The approximate number of patches you will get from this amount of fabric
