Well Ladies. I've seen the Robins arrive now I'm looking forward to spring flowers!


I really enjoyed our March speaker, Sandy Lindal of Scrappy Gal Quilt Co., hope you did too.

What Gina has in store for us this month...




Red Cross Quilts - Photos by Anne Balanyk
