

Things to Bring to the Next Meeting: February 23, 2015

Name Tag Show and Share Library Books Theme fat quarters for draw – amethyst Block of the Month with Jackie Syer—just for fun! Items for the Freebie Table Patience, understanding, warmth, fellowship and a sense of humour!



Pattern from-McCall's Quick Quilts-August/September 2014 Twister come in a lot of sizes today I am using 2 ¼ inch twister You will be using 3 ½ squares What fun about the twister that you can use up a lot of scraps fabric You need 18- 3 ½ squares fall colours & 4-3 ½ squares of the back ground fabric When placing squares together-make sure there is a contrast between the squares 2-18 inches & 2-26 inch strips of 2inch back ground fabric Sew 3 ½ strips together -press–sew back ground fabric around out side-press Take your Twister ruler-position on the large pieced square, right side up, At any seam intersection, aligning marked lines with seam Using fabric marker or pens- mark around the twister I cut out with scissors it's a great job for the evening in front of the T.V. You can cut out with the rotary cuter, but be careful you do not go over the lines Place on a large tray or piece of cardboard as you cut them out

Sew one row at a time-press each row the opposite way-butt rows together & sew

Twister -Jazzy Jack-





Use the twister ruler- same as for Jazzy Jack- instruction For border-you need 3 ½ squares- dark & light And contrasting 2 inch stripes for the borders, top & bottom Sew the squares together and a border on each side, top & bottoms Take your Twister ruler-position on the large pieced square, right side up, At any seam intersection, aligning marked lines with seam Using fabric marker or pens- mark around the twister
