QUILT SHOW TOONIE DRAW

A “Toonie Draw” is a form of raffle, with a number being assigned to a prize. At our Quilt Show, prizes will be small quilts/ wall-hangings (perimeter no larger than 96” - about 24”x24”) or small stitched items. Tickets will be sold 5 for \$2. Tickets are dropped into a numbered container corresponding with the numbered prize. A ticket drawn at random from each container determines the winner. Two draws will be held - one on each day of the quilt show.
